




After you remember your loved ones, consider leaving a gift to Sierra Club BC in your will. A charitable gift in your will can reduce the taxable impact on your beneficiaries by reducing taxes on your estate.

Here are some ways to include Sierra Club BC in your estate plans:

Gift in your will

A bequest is the money or property you legally leave in your will. You can name a specific dollar amount, residual amount or a piece of property, such as a home or securities.

Simply add our legal name and Canadian charitable number and the intention of your gift:

Suggested sample wording: I give to The Sierra Club of BC Foundation, charitable number 11914 9797 RR0001 ___ per cent of the residue of my estate (or the sum of \$)

Gift of Life Insurance


You can name us as the owner or beneficiary of your life insurance policy or retirement plan. Contact your retirement plan administrator or life insurance company and complete the appropriate beneficiary designation form. The payments you make may be tax-deductible.

Charitable Remainder Trust

A charitable remainder trust allows you to secure a charitable gift for the future while retaining income interest on your assets throughout your life.


